

Our president Philip Cheong receives the King Charles II Coronation Medal



Philip Cheong was truly honoured on March 26th, 2025 with the presentation of the King Charles III Coronation Medal in recognition of his volunteer work with the Royal Ontario Museum, an agency of the Government of Ontario and Canada's largest museum devoted to both culture and science. The Canadian version of the Coronation Medal was created to mark the Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III, which took place on May 6, 2023. It is the first Canadian commemorative medal to mark a coronation and 30,000 medals were awarded across the Nation with 4,000 reserved for the Canadian Forces. Seven long time ROM volunteers were honoured. Presenting the medals to the recipients were Josh Basseches, Director and CEO of the ROM, Janice Price, President and CEO of the ROM Governors and Robert Chant, Chair of the ROM Board of Trustees.
